WHAT WE DO

Repercussion Theatre has a nearly 40-year history of making Shakespeare accessible to the public through free English performances in Montreal's parks. Every summer, we put on a different Shakespeare play (or occasionally a different classical playwright) and tour the island, bringing the Bard's words through a modern lens to a variety of audiences.

QUICK & EFFICIENT

Our set-up and strike was thought out to require the least amount of time as possible.

- 3PM - Our team arrives to set up our stage.
- 7PM - The play starts, entrance is free of charge.
- 11PM - We are packed up and out of there!

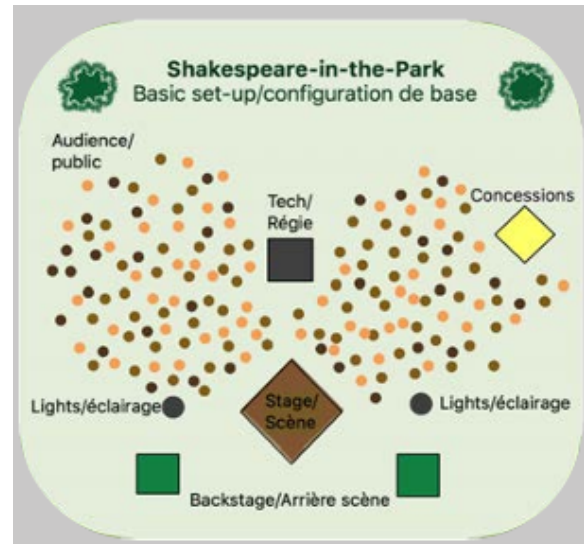
TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The Shakespeare-in-the-Park tour is made to be self-sufficient, requiring the least amount of work on your part. We've even got our own green and efficient batteries, no need to connect to your power grid! You can just relax and enjoy the show with the rest of the crowd. In order to make this happen, here is what we need:

PERFORMANCE SITE

We need a relatively level (ideally grassy) space that is approximately 100 feet squared. We need to have exclusive access to that space from about 3PM to 11PM on the day of performance.

All of the theatre's vehicles (2 trucks and 3 vans) need to be granted direct access to the site for unloading and loading, as well as accessible parking close to the performance site.



BASIC NECESSITIES

We need adequate on-site washroom facilities (these can be in the form of PortaToilets placed near the performance area) that must be available from 3PM to 11PM on the day of performance. We also need access to drinking water while the Theatre is on site. Let us know in advance if water will not be available.

RAIN VENUE

Ideally the park has access to an alternate location (i.e. an auditorium, a theatre, or a large multipurpose room) ready to host a scaled-down version of the performance should the weather make an outdoor performance impossible. This locale should be discussed and approved by the Theatre and the venue together.
